- 一、本系為提升學生升學暨就業競爭力,依據「銘傳大學學生畢業資格檢 定實施辦法」,訂定「銘傳大學安全管理學系專業基本能力檢定實施 細則」(以下簡稱本細則)。
- 二、九十九學年度起入學之大學部學生,應通過本校所定之「服務學習」、 「英語能力」、「資訊能力」、「中文能力」及「運動能力」畢業資 格檢定標準,及本細則所定「基本能力」之檢定標準,始得畢業。

三、學生應於在學期間內通過基本能力檢定,其項目及檢定標準如下:

- 四、學生於畢業前未達前點所定基本能力檢定標準者,應加修本系主任指定專業課程共計4學分,並於該課程達及格標準後,始得畢業。
- 五、通過基本能力檢定標準之學生,應將成績或其他相關證明文件,送至 本系經審核通過後,成績以「檢定通過」登錄。
- 六、本要點經系務、院務及教務會議通過後,報請校長核定後實施,修正時亦同。

Ming Chuan University Enforcement Rules for Security Management Department Professional Competencies Requirements

Passed at the Department Affairs Committee Meeting on January 14, 2010

Passed at the School Affairs Committee Meeting on May 6, 2010

Revised and passed at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting on June 3, 2010

- In accordance with the Ming Chuan University Procedures for Proficiency-based Graduation Requirements, these regulations were established to improve students' competitiveness for their future careers and further studies.
- 2. To attain graduation eligibility, undergraduate students admitted in the 2010-11 academic year and beyond must meet the graduation requirements specified in these procedures and the enforcement rules for Service-Learning, English proficiency, Information Technology proficiency, Chinese proficiency and Sports capability, as well as the professional competencies stated in these regulations.
- 3. Students are required to meet the professional competencies outlined below during their period of study.

Degree Program	Professional Competencies	Requirements
Undergraduate Division	Specialized capability in the area of security management	Students are required to obtain at least one of the certificates listed below (1) Community Safety Manager (Class C) (2) Certified Operational Risk Manager (Class C) (3) Other certificates recognized by the Department.
	Employment competitiveness	In accordance with the Department's enforcement rules for conducting student internships, students must complete 240 hours in the internship program prior to graduation.

- 4. Students who fail to meet the requirements for professional capability must enroll in and pass professional courses (a total of four 4 credits) appointed by the department to attain graduation eligibility.
- 5. Students who meet the graduation requirements for these professional competencies should submit relevant certificates or score reports to the Security Management Department. After completion of these procedures, the students will be verified as meeting the graduation requirements
- 6. Upon being passed at the Department/School/Academic Affairs Committee Meetings and approved by the president, the enforcement rules were implemented. Any revision must follow the same procedures.
